

# Torrance Public Library Presents: Button Moon Collage "Take and Make" Adult Craft


Create a unique moon picture using card stock, a label to create a sticky area, and a variety of buttons.

by making Moon Art using this craft kit!





**Supplies Provided:**  
Paper with moon outline  
Full page label sheet  
Buttons and sequins

**You Will Need to Provide:**  
Scissors & Pencil





Cut out the moon shape printed on the black cardstock paper.



2

Trim the edges of the label so it is smaller than the black paper, but will cover the moon cutout. (Save these strips to make stars)

Placing the label white side down, remove one corner of the backing from the label. CAREFULLY place the black paper on top of the sticky label starting in one corner. Slowly remove the rest of the label backing and press black paper down on the sticker.

**CAUTION**  
**THE LABEL IS VERY STICKY. BE CAREFUL NOT TO PLACE STICKY SIDE ON TABLE. ONCE PLACED, IT CANNOT BE MOVED.**

Begin adding buttons to the sticky area covering the moon. ONCE PLACED, THE BUTTONS CANNOT BE MOVED.

Create a design of large and small buttons. Add some of your own buttons or beads. Use the sequins last to fill in small gaps.

Create stars by drawing them on the backing side of the extra label strips. Cut out the stars, peel off the backing, and stick them in the night sky.
